- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17IN **"SAFETY** CHECKPOINT" **MEANS** (A) THIS SECTION, Α PREDETERMINED FIXED LOCATION AT WHICH A POLICE OFFICER STOPS A 18 19 MOTOR VEHICLE OR A SPECIFIC SEQUENCE OF MOTOR VEHICLES TO CONDUCT 20SAFETY INSPECTIONS, CHECK DRIVER'S LICENSES AND REGISTRATIONS, AND 21EVALUATE DRIVERS FOR IMPAIRMENT.

- 22 (B) (1) THIS SECTION APPLIES TO A SAFETY CHECKPOINT THAT:
- 23 (I) TARGETS THE GENERAL PUBLIC;

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(II) IS CONDUCTED ON A RANDOM BASIS; AND

2 (III) IS NOT CONDUCTED ON SUSPICION OF ILLEGAL 3 ACTIVITY.

4 (2) THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO A SAFETY CHECKPOINT 5 TARGETING COMMON CARRIERS, MOTOR CARRIERS, TRUCK TRACTORS, OR 6 TRAILERS OR SEMITRAILERS.

7 (C) A POLICE OFFICER AT A SAFETY CHECKPOINT MAY NOT TARGET A 8 SPECIFIC TYPE OF MOTOR VEHICLE.

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
10 October 1, 2012.

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
