10. Description and Purpose of Grantee Organization (Limit Length to Visible area)				
<p>The Olney Police Satellite Station opened in 1997. The Olney Chamber of Commerce oversees the operation and maintenance of the station and the Olney Police Satellite Station Fund Advisory Board oversees all donations and funding of expenses related to the station. The Satellite Station serves a multitude of purposes to include: a visual deterrent to crime in the area; a place where local business owners and residents can ask questions, report crimes, and interact with local police officers; offers the police officers serving this area a place to stop and get out of their vehicle, check reports, and go to the restroom in a safe environment while on duty. Most importantly, the station allows a quicker response time to calls.</p>				

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit Length to Visible area)

Since 1997 the trailer that houses the Olney Police Satellite Station has deteriorated and is in need of a major upgrade. Plans are: corner moldings replaced, heat return grill replaced, outlet covers replaced in the reception area; paint the interior of the station; and paint, trim shrubs, replace rotted siding, install rolled roofing/membrane on roof, secure handrail on steps, replace skirting on trailer, sand and reseal handicap ramp, add walkway to side entrance of the exterior of the trailer.
