10. Description and Purpose of Grantee Or				rganization (Limit Length to Visible area)								
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The purpose of the Art League of Ocean City is to promote the visual arts in the Ocean City area through art education and instruction, art exhibitions, scholarship programs, and community art events.

The organization is a 501c3 non profit, serving all ages of the community including children, teens, adults, and senior citizens. The organization is supported by the membership dues of it's approximately 400 individual and business sponsors. All activities are open to the public, and many are provided free of charge.

The organization partners with other non profits, and assists the Town of Ocean City in special events such as Arts Alive and Springfest.

The vision of the organization is to provide a regional center for all forms of art that promotes, stimulates, inspires, encourages and provides for the creation, sharing, appreciation and enjoyment of arts for all members of the community, offered in a spacious and functional upgraded facility.

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit Length to Visible area)

The project is to construct a 7,500 sq ft multi level facility which will encompass dedicated classroom space for art instruction, two art gallery spaces that can accomodate a variety of exhibits, a pottery studio with potter wheels and kiln, and a community room where people can gather for meetings, lectures, dance classes, films, and other purposes.

Also included in the building are four artists studio spaces where working artists can have a place to produce and display their artwork.

In addition an artist in residence studio will be on premise, where artists can use the space to produce a body of work which engages the community on a short term basis. There will also be computer workstations for the instruction of digital art and graphic design. An art library for children and adults will be featured, as well as office space, a warming kitchen, and much needed storage space.

There is no duplication of services in the area, in fact, there is a lack of other cultural opportunities in the Ocean City area.

Art inspires, educates and empowers people to think creatively and be their most productive selves. Children who have been exposed to the arts perform better in school, and have higher self esteem.

This facility will be the cornerstone of culture in the Town of Ocean City, and will expose the public to a diverse range of art activities that they cannot find anywhere else in Worcester County, thereby enhancing the quality of life for the residents.

The new structure will be ADA compliant, and will be multi functional in purpose. In addition, programming will be offered to every age group and costs are kept at a minimum so that all economic segments can be reached.

Educational opportunities for youth include: art instruction, school field trips, youth art exhibits, scholarships for high school students wishing to pursue a degree in the arts, and a summer art camp.

Educational and recreational opportunities will be provided to the growing retirement population including: art workshops, exhibitions, lecture and film series, as well as opportunities to volunteer in a meaningful way.

In conclusion, the new Ocean City Center for the Arts is vital to the economic growth and sustainability of our community. The benefits that will be realized from the project far outway the costs, and the project will enhance the brand of the resort, and the quality of life for the year round population.
