10. Description and Purpose of Grantee Organization (Limit Length to Visible area)									

The Grantee is a municipal local government responsible for management and administration of all city functions including the operation and management of the public works functions. The Mayor and City Council has designated a Committee to establish a Veterans Memorial Park in the city that will be located on the corner of McLain Avenue and Reed Street. The memorial park would be close to the main Martin Luther King Highway and will be a desirable final site for selection and design. The purpose of the Committee is to plan, construct and administer a memorial that would commemorate all Glenarden Veterans of all national wars. The Committee has recommended to the Mayor and City Council to build and construct the new memorial park on city owned land with the help of the Neighborhood Design Center, Inc., a non-profit 501-c (3) organization in Prince George's County.

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit Length to Visible area)

The Veterans Memorial Park will pay tribute to veterans from the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marine Corps, Coast Guard, Merchant Marines, as well as MIA/POW's and will encompass approximately 6,000 square feet of ground at the corner of McLain Avenue and Reed Street. Strategically placed in an area that has recently accepted a new Parks and Planning Recreation Center and Community Swimming Pool, the memorial park will be built on city owned land with the memorial becoming an important destination place for veterans and their families as well as a solemn place for local residents to enjoy and pay their respects to our fallen heroes. Veterans will be recognized with individually engraved bricks listing the veteran's name, rank, and branch of service throughout the site. The memorial is designed with a semi-circular brick monument wall surrounding medallions representing the branches of service, topped with stone coping; a stone monument and flag poles representing the branches of service will be installed behind the monument wall. The memorial design also includes sidewalks, stairs, a handicap accessible ramp, and lighting with specially designed park benches. The project will serve all veterans from Glenarden with residents of Maryland and Prince George's County invited along with visitors along MD Route 704.
