11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit Length to Visible area)

The Town of Riverdale Park is in the process of renovating its Council Chambers in Town Hall to create a new Youth and Community wing. The additional 7,000 square feet of space would accommodate Town Council needs, but would primarily be used for youth and community access. Town Hall's close proximity to Riverdale Elementary School offers an ideal after-school location. Space may be used for the Riverdale Boys and Girls Club, local dance troupes, Girl Scouts, Boy Scouts, after school programs, learning centers, and sports equipment storage.

The Youth and Community Wing project will increase the use at Town Hall from 50 people to approximately 400 people. The Town is currently in the design phase of this project.
