## 10. Description and Purpose of Grantee Organization (Limit Length to Visible area)

Community Outreach and Development Community Development Corporation is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization that was established in the year 2000 whose mission is developing and implementing programs to better the quality of life for families and individuals. Our vision is to provide quality services that enable persons to become self-sufficient and productive members of the community. The organization primarily serves persons in Prince Georges County. We have three main service areas: Education, Economic Development, and Human Services. The programs implemented are focused on nurturing self-empowerment, which we believe creates a better quality of life for those persons who contact us. Each year, we serve more than 6,500 individuals, with everything from food, clothing, financial assistance, and workforce development activities.

## 11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit Length to Visible area)

The project will complete the renovation of the Labor of Love Learning Center, which will provide a state-of-the-art educational facility and provide quality care for 100 infants, toddlers, and before-and after-school children. The renovation phase includes: purchase and installation of playground equipment, installation of an elevator, heating and air conditioning units, and flooring. Installation of these items is necessary and critical to the operations of the Center, by allowing for ADA accessibility and providing at-risk children with quality facilities and programming. The project is shovel-ready, and will provide affordable educational services that will accept daycare vouchers and an income-based sliding scale fee. This will provide 25 job opportunities for low-income residents in collaboration with the Prince Georges County Department of Human Resources, and meals will be provided through a partnership with Prince Georges Community Colleges Hospitality Express: Culinary Arts program.
