+The southern Maryland Carousel Group's purpose is to generate an interest in American folk art while preserving Southern Maryland history by creating a unique facility in Southern Maryland housing a full-size working carousel, museum of Marshall Hall artifacts, carving implements, and a woodcarving learning center.

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit Length to Visible area)

Enhancing the tourism trade in Southern Maryland, this unique 12,000 square foot facility will provide space for a full-size working carousel, a museum displaying the history of Marshall Hall and memorabilia about that era. A learning center where wood-carving and general wood working skills will be taught to youth and adults. This facility will serve all of Southern Maryland and tourists coming to the area.

A Manager and two additional personnel will be able to operate the carousel, museum and gift shop with some additional part-time help and volunteers in the learning center.

28. Comments: (Limit Length to Visible area)

The Southern Maryland Carousel Group, Inc. began its "Kids for the Carousel Program" with permission from the Charles County School Board, for the purpose of getting the children involved in learning about the carousel, how a carousel works, and most important how the horses are put together. We accomplished this through hands on demonstrations and going to career and fun days at their respective schools. We also talked to them about having their mascot represented on the Carousel. Thus far we have five schools in Charles County and one in St. Mary's County who have raised funds to have their mascot on the carousel. We have made direct contact with approximately 2,000 children in the schools.

The Carousel group has put on demonstrations for the Lions Clubs of Charles County, the Rotary Club, Antique Arts Association, Nanjemoy Days, Charles County Fair, Waldorf Moms Club, the Greater Waldorf Jaycees and Compassionate Friends. The Lions Clubs of Charles County adopted a Lion, Compassionate Friends adopted a horse to honor their lost children and the Waldorf Jaycees have adopted two handicapped accessible chariots. A member of the Rotary Club adopted two horses for their family. We had contact with over 5,000 people at these events. Our carving center is open to the public; we have had numerous visitors come from all over the country to watch the process of building an animal. In total 17 animals and two chariots have been adopted.

The Southern Maryland Carousel Group is continually educating the children in our school system. Through a grant we received from the Charles County Historic Trust, Inc. we were able to produce a video of "Memories of Marshall Hall and also printed several thousand copes of a brochure about Marshall Hall. This publication has several math problems for children to solve and also a carousel animal for the children to color. Prior to this no history brochure existed. This brochure has been distributed to the National Park Service Visitors Center, Ft. Washington, MD, Newburg Visitors Center, the Chamber of Commerce and the Charles County Department of Tourism.
