10. Description and Purpose of Grantee Organization (Limit Length to Visible area)							
The Montgomery County Department of Transportation (MCDOT) mission is to provide an effective and efficient transportation system. The mission of the MCDOT Division of Transit Services is to provide an effective mix of public transportation services in Montgomery County.							

The Division's Commuter Services Section centralizes commuter services efforts and promotes transportation alternatives to the single occupant vehicle throughout Montgomery County, including bikesharing.

Montgomery County proposes to expand its low-cost transportation options through bikesharing to allow individuals to connect with transit, jobs and activity centers by bicycle in a safe and convenient manner. Adding to the County's already substantial efforts to provide and promote standard bike facilities, bikesharing will increase bicycle mode share and achieve these goals. By promoting bicycling for short trips of less than 3 miles, and for the first mile and last mile of longer transit trips, bikesharing maximizes existing infrastructure by extending the reach of rail and bus transit in an effective, innovative, and low-cost manner.

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit Length to Visible area)

The requested funds would be used to implement a substantial portion of a \$2.15 million Capital Program for a bikesharing system in lower Montgomery County focused on the two legs of the Metrorail Red Line and major activity centers.

Phase I includes 29 stations and 204 bikes extending from the District line to Friendship Heights, Bethesda, and Medical Center on the west leg of the Metrorail Red Line, and Takoma Park and Silver Spring on the east leg of the Metrorail Red Line. The system will connect with Metrorail, MARC and MTA commuter bus at the Silver Spring Transit Center.

Phase II includes 21 stations and 142 bikes to expand north along the east leg of the Red Line to Forest Glen and Wheaton, while adding stations to Silver Spring, Bethesda, and Friendship Heights; and connecting the west and east corridors via the Georgetown Branch Trail.

Round all amounts to the nearest \$1,000. The totals in Items 12 (Estimated Capital Costs) and 13 (Proposed Funding Sources) must match. The proposed funding sources must not include the value of real property unless an equivalent value is shown under Estimated Capital Costs.

Stations Proposed for Lower Montgomery County Bikeshare System: The ultimate vision is for a bikeshare network extending along, and fanning out from, both legs of the Metrorail Red Line, serving activity centers throughout Montgomery County, and facilitating connections with the entire range of existing and future transit services, including MARC, MTA commuter buses, Ride On, Metrobus, and potential future light rail and/or BRT services. The lower Montgomery County system outlined here will facilitate reaching that ultimate vision by promoting bikeshare/transit connections between the downcounty and the Rockville/Shady Grove area where other bikeshare funding has been obtained.
