The Knights of St. John Hall the former Woodville School building						

The Knights of St. John Hall the former Woodville School building is a one story frame building with a hip roof built in 1934. The building is in need of major repairs, renovation and reconstruction. The roof leaks and has damaged the interior ceiling and historical items. The electrical system has not been upgraded since the building was purchased in 1956. The plumbing system has had some minor repairs. Presently, the bathrooms and kitchen need a total upgrade including replacing the equipment. A handicapped ramp is needed to meet State Health Requirements. This reconstruction project is critical to preserve and maintain the building so it can continue to be used by the citizens, their families and organizations to have, family events and civic activities. It will also be available as a historic Tour Site.

28. Comments: (Limit Length to Visible area) The Knights of St. John Commandery 373 purchased the Woodville School from the Prince George's County Board of Education in 1956. The building was then named the Knights of St. John Hall. The building is located in Aquasco, the Southern area of Prince Georges County of 2.65 acres of land. In 1993 the Knights of St. John Hall was classified as an Historical Site by the Prince George's County Historic Preservation Commission. From the very beginning the Knights Hall was made available for community use. Individuals, families, civic groups and organizations were very grateful to use the building for a donation which was used to supplement the building's insurance. electrical and hearing bills. Over the years the hall has been used for meetings, family reunions, wedding receptions, educational/recreational programs for the community youth, fund raisers, birthday/anniversary celebrations, family repast, vard sales and organizational workshops. During the last few years, sadly the use of the hall has been limited for community use because of the need of the building's repair and upgrade such as the electrical system for safety, the plumbing system for sanitation, the kitchen equipment for fund raising, the installation of the air condition system and a handicapped ramp for health and safety purposes. The Knights Hall is the only historic building in the area available for community use.
