<p>The Town of Chesapeake Beach, Maryland is a municipal corporation providing a broad array of public services to its citizens. This includes recreational services through cooperative arrangements with Calvert County, to non-profit organizations and by direct sponsorship of groups providing recreational opportunities.</p>

The youth of the Town of Chesapeake Beach, Maryland have asked the Mayor and Town Council to build a Skateboard Park at its Kellams Field Recreation Complex. The park will be incorporated into the Town's existing recreation complex, which includes a lighted field for football, lacrosse and baseball; a tot lot; a water park; and a community center with a basketball gym and meeting rooms.

The Town's Skateboard Park will be approximately 10,000 square feet and constructed out of concrete.
