<b>10. Description and Purpose of Grantee Organization</b> (Limit Length to Visible area)								
Baltimore County seeks these funds to support the work of NeighborSpace of Baltimore County, a nonprofit land trust organization that the County helped to create in 2003 to conserve and improve land within the County's growth line or URDL. The communities within the URDL, like Catonsville, Woodlawn, Pikesville, Essex and Dundalk were built before there were open space								
regulations. Ninety (90) percent of the County's 805,000 residents live within these communities. NeighborSpace seeks to enhance these communities through the acquisition and improvement of								

NeighborSpace seeks to enhance these communities through the acquisition and improvement of public open space for small parks, gardens and natural areas and to increase property values and neighborhood quality. NeighborSpace leverages public and private funding with its ability, as a qualified land trust, to secure donated land.

## 11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit Length to Visible area)

(1) Acquisition of private property in Gwynns Falls watershed area for purposes of greenway extension, stormwater management and public open space. The conservation of this property is important, not only because public open space is in short supply, but because this watershed area has been reported as having the largest area of communities at risk for environmental justice conditions related to water quality in Baltimore County. (2) Acquisition of privately owned land to complete the Maryland Line walking trail from Bear Creek Branch to Battle Acre Park; an area rich in history related to the War of 1812 and the Battle of North Point. (3) Improve parcels owned by NeighborSpace, where grading, soil amendment and invasive species removal are necessary to make the space usable, particularly in the Robin Hill Park. Working with the Morgan State University Landscape Architecture Program and the community NeighborSpace has developed a design for this particular site and hopes to continue this in other areas.(4)Develop a Strategic conservation Plan to continue the conservation of land. Need to hire data analysis for a comprehensive plan.
