10. Description and Purpose of Grantee Organization (Limit Length to Visible area)

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit Length to Visible area)

The Broad Creek Memorial Scout Reservation waste water discharge and management treatment system is being required by the State of Maryland Department of the Environment and the Harford County Health Department in order to bring the current aging systems in compliance and to insure an adequate waste water management system is in place to provide for future plans and activity at the site.

The system will be constructed on property owned and operated by the Baltimore Area Council, Boy Scouts of America at the Broad Creek Memorial Scout Reservation (BCMSR), a 1700-acre environmentally diverse property in the Chesapeake Bay watershed.

The Baltimore Area Council, Boy Scouts of America is collaborating with the MDE, Harford County Health Department, Maryland Environmental Services and several private consultants and engineering firms to insure that this project is successful.

The system will be built on property owned and operated by the Baltimore Area Council, Boy Scouts of America (BAC, BSA) at the Broad Creek Memorial Scout Reservation (BCMSR), a 1,700-acre environmentally diverse property in the Chesapeake Bay Watershed. The property provides important youth development and environmental education for 30,000 Boy Scout campers annually as well as approximately 6,000 youth in non-boy Scout groups including schools, governments, community, church groups and other non-profit organizations including Girl Scouts, Boys and Girls Clubs, Cal Ripkin Foundation, Royal Ranges, NAACP youth program, Maryland DNR and Harford County High Schools.
The successful completion of this project will insure that quality outdoor programs will continue at Broad Creek Memorial Scout Reservation for future generations of Maryland's young people.
