The Metropolitan Center for the Visual Arts (VisArts) is a nonprofit arts center dedicated to engaging the community in the arts and providing opportunities for artistic exploration, education and participation. Located in Rockville, Maryland, VisArts is the cultural anchor for the newly developed Rockville Town Square, a large mixed use development featuring restaurants, shops, residential units focused around a traditional town square design.

Through educational programming, gallery exhibitions and a resident artist program, VisArts provides children, teens and adults with opportunities to express their creativity and enhance their awareness of the arts. Each year VisArts welcomes more than 8,500 visitors to participate in art education classes and camp programs, attend events, visit our three galleries, or observe our resident artists at work in their studios on our artist concourse.

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit Length to Visible area)

This project has three goals. The first is to retrofit our public bathrooms with handicapped accessible door openers so that visitors and employees confined to a wheelchair can exit our rest rooms without assistance. Since we provide programming for many disabled adults and children and have a full time wheelchair-bound volunteer, this retrofitting must be done to make our facility accessible and usable to all. The second purpose of this project is the renovation of our event space to provide the organization with a more durable and flexible flooring surface. The approximately 2,800 square feet space is totally carpeted and does not permit us to offer dance, theater or even art programs. The new flooring, with a useful life in excess of fifteen years, will permit VisArts to support more varied and interesting programming. The last project is to purchase window coverings to deal with the solar heat gain we experience during the summer months. All of VisArts space has floor to ceiling windows that are not sufficiently tinted. The heat gain through these windows makes much of our space uninhabitable during the summer months. Purchasing shades would result in substantial cost savings to the organization and expand our programming options.

28. Comments: (Limit Length to Visible area)

The Metropolitan Center for the Visual Arts began twenty five years ago as Rockville Arts Place, an organization dedicated to supporting artists and art lovers alike through exhibitions, affordable studio space and classes. In 2005 the City of Rockville in partnership with private developers and the State of Maryland began a large scale redevelopment project to build Rockville Town Square. VisArts raised over three million dollars in private funding to build out the interior space of our new 25,000 square foot building that includes 9 resident artist studios, three gallery spaces as well as ceramics, glass, photography, digital arts, woodworking and general art classrooms.

The projects that we are seeking financial assistance with deal with retrofitting our building to address handicap accessibility, solar heat gain and limitations in our programming options.

VisArts provides art instruction to disabled adults and teens who come to our facility through Community Support Services (CSS) and Community Service for Autism Adults and Children (CSAAC). VisArts has many developmentally and physically impaired adults as gallery docents and office helpers. These volunteers come to VisArts through the Target Corporation, Amtrack and Unlimited Work Opportunities. The volunteers are often stranded in our bathrooms because they cannot manuever their wheelchair through the rest room doors.

VisArts occupies the first three floors of the Arts and Innovation Center- a contemporary glass and metal building that, while very beautiful, becomes unbearably hot during the summer months. Large parts of our space become unusable and our cooling bills reflect the lack of appropriate window tinting or coverings. Purchasing commercial window shades with a useful life of more than fifteen years will allow us to reclaim currently unusable space for additional programming.

The last project that VisArts is seeking funding for would replace the carpet in our large event space with durable ceramic coated vinyl flooring. The flooring is maintenance free and has an expected useful life of 18 years or more. The primary reason for this project is to permit VisArts to expand our classes, programs and activities to include more dance, exercise and theater programs that are not possible with a carpeted surface. For VisArts, gaining this large space as a potential visual and performing art space would have a significant impact on our financial sustainability and permit us to greatly expand programming to our community.

FUNDING- Operating expenses will continue to be met with programming income and donations. The three renovation/retrofitting projects will be expensive and State funding is vital if we are to address these important facility needs and continue to grow.
