11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit Length to Visible area)

Rockville Swim and Fitness Center - Renovate Locker Room facility to improve ADA Accessibility, Customer Safety, and Wellness. Design is 95% complete. The total project cost is \$792,239 in FY13. The bond bill request would be to fund \$200,000 to support the project. This project will provide needed renovations that will address ADA, safety issues, make the building more energy efficient, and improve usability and security for customers. The facility does not meet current building codes for life safety or accessibility. This facility serves 71,000+ visits during the outdoor pool season. The facility was part of an original Municipal Swim Center construction in 1968. Originally designed to support one outdoor pool, currently, the the building supports the recreation pool as well as the Olympic size pool and the sprayground. No significant improvements have been completed since its original construction. Each year the City must spend thousands of dollars to repair the building just to open for business.
