<p>The Owings Mills High School Sports Boosters is a volunteer organization made up of parents and school staff whose primary goal is to provide support for the athletic programs at Owings Mills High School (OMHS). Over the past twenty years, money raised through membership dues, concessions, and other fundraising events has helped provide new uniforms, equipment, upgraded facilities, college scholarships for graduating seniors, and assisted with transportation expenses. The OMHS Sports Boosters will continue to promote school spirit, pride, and encourage a well rounded education through participation in sports.</p>

Phase one of the project will be under way this spring (2012). Phase one includes new bleachers and a press box which do not currently exist. Phase two, to which these grants would apply would include visitor side bleachers and rest rooms within the field area. Neither of these items currently exist. Student athletes and those attending games have to go back into OMHS to use the rest room facilities. This is a considerable distance from the playing fields and represents a potential safety issue with people entering the school.
