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## Vehicle Laws - Special Registration Plate - United States Armed Forces

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Motor Vehicle Administration to develop and make 4 available for certain vehicles a special registration plate honoring the armed 5 forces of the United States; authorizing certain persons to apply for the special 6 registration plate; requiring certain owners of vehicles assigned a special 7 registration plate under this Act to pay certain fees; requiring that certain fees 8 be used only for certain purposes; requiring a registration plate issued under 9 this Act to contain a certain graphic design and certain words; requiring the Administration to adopt regulations to carry out the provisions of this Act; and 10 generally relating to a special registration plate honoring the armed forces of 11 12 the United States.

- 18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 20 Article Transportation
- 21 **13–619.3.**
- 22 (A) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL DEVELOP AND MAKE AVAILABLE FOR 23 QUALIFYING VEHICLES A SPECIALLY DESIGNED REGISTRATION PLATE
- 24 HONORING THE ARMED FORCES OF THE UNITED STATES.

- 1 (B) THE OWNER OF A VEHICLE, OR A LESSEE OF THE VEHICLE UNDER A
  2 LEASE NOT INTENDED AS SECURITY, OR A DIRECTOR, AN OFFICER, AN
  3 EMPLOYEE, OR A PARTNER OF A BUSINESS ENTITY THAT OWNS THE VEHICLE
  4 CONSIDERED ELIGIBLE BY THE ADMINISTRATION MAY APPLY TO THE
  5 ADMINISTRATION FOR AN ORIGINAL OR A SUBSTITUTE REGISTRATION PLATE
- 6 UNDER THIS SECTION IF THE VEHICLE IS INCLUDED IN ONE OF THE FOLLOWING
- 7 CLASSES:
- 8 (1) A CLASS A (PASSENGER) VEHICLE;
- 9 (2) A CLASS D (MOTORCYCLE) VEHICLE;
- 10 (3) A CLASS E (TRUCK) VEHICLE WITH A MANUFACTURER'S 11 RATED CAPACITY OF 1 TON OR LESS;
- 12 (4) A CLASS G (TRAILER) VEHICLE; OR
- 13 (5) A CLASS M (MULTIPURPOSE) VEHICLE.
- 14 (C) (1) IN ADDITION TO THE ANNUAL REGISTRATION FEE OTHERWISE 15 REQUIRED UNDER THIS TITLE, AN OWNER OF A VEHICLE ASSIGNED A
- 16 REGISTRATION PLATE UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL PAY:
- 17 (I) WHEN INITIALLY ISSUED THE REGISTRATION PLATE, A
- 18 ONE-TIME FEE SET BY THE ADMINISTRATION TO RECOVER THE
- 19 ADMINISTRATION'S COSTS UNDER THIS SECTION; AND
- 20 (II) WHEN INITIALLY ISSUED THE REGISTRATION PLATE,
- 21 AND EACH TIME THE REGISTRATION PLATE IS RENEWED, AN ADDITIONAL FEE
- 22 SET BY THE ADMINISTRATION OF AT LEAST \$20 TO BENEFIT THE MARYLAND
- 23 CHAPTER OF DISABLED AMERICAN VETERANS.
- 24 (2) THE ADDITIONAL FEE COLLECTED UNDER THIS SECTION IS
- 25 NOT REQUIRED FOR SPECIAL REGISTRATION OF A VEHICLE THAT IS EXEMPT
- 26 UNDER § 13–903 OF THIS TITLE.
- 27 (3) NO PORTION OF THE FEE COLLECTED UNDER THIS SECTION
- 28 MAY BE CREDITED TO THE GASOLINE AND MOTOR VEHICLE REVENUE
- 29 ACCOUNT FOR DISTRIBUTION UNDER § 8-403 OR § 8-404 OF THIS ARTICLE.
- 30 (D) A REGISTRATION PLATE ISSUED UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL
- 31 INCLUDE A GRAPHIC DESIGN OF A BALD EAGLE AND THE WORDS "SUPPORT
- 32 MARYLAND VETERANS".

- 1 (E) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 4 October 1, 2012.
