## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

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Economic Development – Maryland Agricultural and Resource–Based Industry Development Corporation – Agricultural Grant Program

4 FOR the purpose of establishing the Agricultural Grant Program; specifying the 5 purpose of the Program; requiring a grant applicant to meet certain eligibility 6 requirements; requiring the Maryland Agricultural and Resource-Based 7 Industry Development Corporation and the Corporation's Board of Directors to 8 develop the Program; requiring the Corporation to administer the Program; 9 requiring a grant applicant to submit certain information in the grant 10 application; requiring the Corporation to consider certain factors when awarding a grant; specifying that a grant from the Program may be used for 11 12 certain purposes; prohibiting a grant from the Program to be used for certain 13 purposes; limiting the amount of a grant awarded under the Program; authorizing the Corporation to limit the amount of funding awarded to a single 14 project; specifying the source of Program funding; requiring that certain 15 16 information be included in the Corporation's annual report; requiring the 17 Secretary of Business and Economic Development to adopt certain regulations; 18 altering the amount of the annual appropriation for the Corporation for certain fiscal years; defining certain terms; and generally relating to the Agricultural 19 20 Grant Program and the Maryland Agricultural and Resource-Based Industry 21 Development Corporation.
