AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 30

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, strike in their entirety lines 2 and 3 and substitute “Crimes – Prohibition on Smoking”; strike beginning with the second “the” in line 4 down through “vehicle” in line 6 and substitute “a person from burning a lighted cigarette, cigar, pipe, or any other device or substance that contains tobacco”; strike beginning with “providing” in line 7 down through “term;” in line 8; in line 9, strike “prohibitions against tobacco smoking in a motor vehicle” and substitute “a prohibition on tobacco smoking”; and strike in their entirety lines 10 through 14, inclusive, and substitute:

“BY adding to

Article - Criminal Law

Section 10-106.1

Annotated Code of Maryland

(2012 Replacement Volume and 2012 Supplement)”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On pages 1 and 2, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 17 on page 1 through line 11 on page 2, inclusive, and substitute:

“Article – Criminal Law

10-106.1.

(A) A PERSON MAY NOT BURN A LIGHTED CIGARETTE, CIGAR, PIPE, OR ANY OTHER DEVICE OR SUBSTANCE THAT CONTAINS TOBACCO.

(Over)

(B) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$50.”.
