AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 541

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 2, strike “Rehabilitation” and substitute “Completion”; strike beginning with “establishing” in line 3 down through “ex-offenders;” in line 4; in lines 4 and 5, strike “Maryland Parole Commission” and substitute “Department of Public Safety and Correctional Services”; in lines 5 and 17, in each instance, strike “rehabilitation” and substitute “completion”; in line 6, strike “eligible”; strike beginning with “providing” in line 6 down through “rehabilitation” in line 16 and substitute “requiring the Department to make a certain report on or before a certain date; providing for the application of this Act”; and in line 20, strike “7-209” and substitute “7-103”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 1, strike “**7-209.**” and substitute “**7-103.**”; in lines 2 and 9, in each instance, strike “**ELIGIBLE**”; strike beginning with “**MEANS**” in line 2 down through “**OFFENSE**” in line 4 and substitute “**HAS THE MEANING STATED IN § 6-101 OF THIS ARTICLE**”; strike in their entirety lines 5 through 7, inclusive; in line 8, strike “**(C)**” and substitute “**(B)**”; in the same line, strike “**COMMISSION**” and substitute “**DEPARTMENT**”; in the same line, strike “**REHABILITATION**” and substitute “**COMPLETION**”; strike in their entirety lines 10 and 11; in lines 12 and 17, strike “**(2)**” and “**(3)**”, respectively, and substitute “**(1)**” and “**(2)**”, respectively; in line 12, strike “**RELEASED FROM A CORRECTIONAL INSTITUTION**” and substitute “**SUPERVISED BY THE DEPARTMENT**”; in line 16, after “**MANDATORY**” insert “**RELEASE**”; in the same line, strike “**AND**”; in line 17, strike “**SUCCESSFULLY**”; in the same line, strike “**THE TERM**” and substitute “**ALL SPECIAL AND GENERAL CONDITIONS**”; in line 19, strike “**FINANCIAL**” and substitute “**PAYMENT**”; and in the same line, strike the period and substitute “**; AND**”

(Over)

(3) IS NO LONGER UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE DEPARTMENT.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, on or before December 31, 2013, the Department of Public Safety and Correctional Services shall report to the Governor and, subject to § 2-1246 of the State Government Article, the General Assembly on the number of certificates of completion issued under this Act.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be construed prospectively to apply only to individuals under the supervision of the Department of Public Safety and Correctional Services on or after July 1, 2013.”.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On pages 2 and 3, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 20 on page 2 through line 31 on page 3, inclusive.

On page 4, in line 1, strike “2.” and substitute “4.”.
