CHAPTER _____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Southern Maryland Higher Education Council – Modifications**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the number of members on the Southern Maryland
4 Higher Education Council; requiring the Maryland Higher Education
5 Commission to provide staff for the Council; altering the deadline for the
6 Council to submit a certain final report; extending the termination provisions
7 relating to the Council; and generally relating to the Southern Maryland Higher
8 Education Council.

9 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
10 Chapter 622 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2011

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Chapter 622 of the Acts of 2011**

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
15 MARYLAND, That:

16 (a) There is a Southern Maryland Higher Education Council.

17 (b) The Council consists of the following [12] **13** members:

1 (1) the Secretary of Higher Education, or the Secretary's designee;

2 (2) the Chancellor of the University System of Maryland, or the
3 Chancellor's designee;

4 (3) the President of St. Mary's College of Maryland, or the President's
5 designee;

6 (4) the President of the College of Southern Maryland, or the
7 President's designee;

8 (5) the President of the Maryland Independent College and University
9 Association, or the President's designee;

10 (6) the Chair of the Board of Governors of the Southern Maryland
11 Higher Education Center, or the Chair's designee;

12 (7) the Assistant Secretary of the Navy for Manpower and Reserve
13 Affairs, or the Assistant Secretary's designee;

14 (8) the Chair of the Governor's Southern Maryland Workforce
15 Investment Board, or the Chair's designee;

16 (9) the President of the Board of Directors of the Patuxent
17 Partnership, or the President's designee;

18 (10) the President of the Board of County Commissioners of Calvert
19 County, or the President's designee;

20 (11) the President of the Board of County Commissioners of Charles
21 County, or the President's designee; [and]

22 (12) the President of the Board of County Commissioners of St. Mary's
23 County, or the President's designee; AND

24 **(13) A MEMBER OF THE PUBLIC WITH EXTENSIVE KNOWLEDGE OF**
25 **HIGHER EDUCATION IN MARYLAND, APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR.**

26 (c) (1) The Governor shall appoint a chair from among the members of the
27 Council.

28 (2) The members may elect other officers and establish committees,
29 including advisory committees, as needed.

30 (d) A member of the Council:

31 (1) may not receive compensation as a member of the Council; but

1 (2) is entitled to reimbursement for expenses under the Standard
2 State Travel Regulations, as provided in the State budget.

3 (e) (1) The Council shall develop a strategy for improving access to higher
4 education for the residents of Southern Maryland.

5 (2) In developing a strategy for improving access to higher education
6 for the residents of Southern Maryland, the Council shall:

7 (i) examine the need for higher education in Southern
8 Maryland;

9 (ii) examine whether or not the current higher education
10 institutions and centers in Southern Maryland, including the Southern Maryland
11 Higher Education Center, are meeting the higher education needs of the region;

12 (iii) if a determination is made that additional higher education
13 needs exist in Southern Maryland, recommend the best way to meet the additional
14 educational needs; and

15 (iv) develop plans that include short-term and long-term
16 strategies for improving access to higher education in Southern Maryland.

17 (f) On or before December 1, 2011, the Council shall present an interim
18 report of its findings and recommendations, including a short-term strategy for
19 improving access to higher education in Southern Maryland, to the Governor and, in
20 accordance with § 2-1246 of the State Government Article, the General Assembly.

21 (g) On or before December 1, [2012] **2013**, the Council shall present a final
22 report of its findings and recommendations, including a long-term strategy for
23 improving access to higher education in Southern Maryland, to the Governor and, in
24 accordance with § 2-1246 of the State Government Article, the General Assembly.

25 **(H) THE MARYLAND HIGHER EDUCATION COMMISSION SHALL**
26 **PROVIDE STAFF FOR THE COUNCIL.**

27 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
28 July 1, 2011. It shall remain effective for a period [2] of **3** years and, at the end of
29 June 30, [2013] **2014**, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this
30 Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.

31 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
32 June 1, 2013.
