3 FOR the purpose of altering the time period before a license expires by which the 4 Board of Examiners of Psychologists is required to send a renewal notice to a  $\mathbf{5}$ licensee; requiring the Board, under certain circumstances, to send a renewal 6 notice by electronic means to a certain electronic mail address of a licensee; 7 requiring the Board, under certain circumstances, to send a renewal notice to a licensee by first-class mail to a certain address of the licensee; requiring each 8 9 licensee to notify the Board in writing of any change in address or electronic 10 mail address within a certain number of days after the change occurs; making 11 certain stylistic changes; and generally relating to license renewal by the State 12 Board of Examiners of Psychologists.
