1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Business Regulation – Other Tobacco Products Wholesalers – License Fee**
3 **Exception for Cigarette Subwholesalers**

4 FOR the purpose of exempting a person who is licensed under a certain provision of
5 law to act as a cigarette subwholesaler from the requirement that an applicant
6 for a license to act as an other tobacco products wholesaler pay a certain license
7 fee; and generally relating to license fee requirements for other tobacco products
8 wholesalers.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article – Business Regulation**

18 (d) (1) An applicant for a license to act as an other tobacco products
19 wholesaler shall:

1 (i) submit an application to the Comptroller on the form and
2 containing the information that the Comptroller requires; and

3 (ii) except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, pay to
4 the Comptroller a fee of \$250.

5 (2) A person who has a license issued under Title 16 of this article to
6 act as a cigarette wholesaler **OR TO ACT AS A CIGARETTE SUBWHOLESALE** is not
7 required to pay the license fee.

8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
9 October 1, 2013.
