A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Veterans Full Employment Act of 2013**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring certain licensing units and boards to give credit to
4 certain former service members for relevant military training, education, and
5 experience in connection with the issuance of certain occupational and
6 professional licenses, certificates, and registrations; repealing and recodifying
7 certain provisions of law regarding the renewal of certain occupational or
8 professional licenses and the completion of continuing education or continuing
9 competency requirements for certain members of an armed force deployed
10 outside the State; requiring certain licensing units and boards to issue a
11 temporary expedited license, certification, or registration to certain individuals
12 under certain circumstances; authorizing certain licensing units and boards to
13 issue a temporary license under certain circumstances; authorizing certain
14 health occupations boards to apply to the Secretary of Health and Mental
15 Hygiene for consideration of an alternate process of expedited licensing,
16 certification, or registration under certain circumstances; requiring the State
17 Superintendent of Schools to expedite educator certification under certain
18 circumstances; authorizing the State Superintendent of Schools to issue a
19 temporary educator certificate under certain circumstances; requiring certain
20 licensing units and boards and the State Department of Education to publish
21 certain information on a certain Web site; authorizing certain licensing units
22 and boards, the Commissioner of Financial Regulation, and the State Board of
23 Education to adopt certain regulations; requiring the Maryland Higher
24 Education Commission to develop and adopt certain guidelines regarding the
25 awarding of academic credit for military training, coursework, and education;
26 requiring public institutions of higher education to develop and implement
27 certain policies in accordance with the guidelines adopted by the Commission;

8 INDICATED.

9 (B) (1) “LICENSE” MEANS ANY GRANT OF AUTHORITY TO AN
10 INDIVIDUAL TO PRACTICE AN OCCUPATION OR PROFESSION.

11 (2) “LICENSE” INCLUDES A CERTIFICATE, PERMIT, OR
12 REGISTRATION.

13 (C) “MILITARY SPOUSE” MEANS THE SPOUSE OF A SERVICE MEMBER OR
14 VETERAN.

15 (D) “SERVICE MEMBER” MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS AN ACTIVE
16 DUTY MEMBER OF:

17 (1) THE ARMED FORCES OF THE UNITED STATES;

18 (2) A RESERVE COMPONENT OF THE ARMED FORCES OF THE
19 UNITED STATES; OR

20 (3) THE NATIONAL GUARD OF ANY STATE.

21 (E) “UNIT” MEANS A UNIT IN THE DEPARTMENT THAT IS AUTHORIZED
22 TO ISSUE A LICENSE.

23 (F) (1) “VETERAN” MEANS A FORMER SERVICE MEMBER WHO WAS
24 HONORABLY DISCHARGED FROM ACTIVE DUTY WITHIN 1 YEAR BEFORE THE
25 DATE ON WHICH THE APPLICATION FOR A LICENSE IS SUBMITTED.

26 (2) “VETERAN” DOES NOT INCLUDE AN INDIVIDUAL WHO HAS
27 COMPLETED ACTIVE DUTY AND HAS BEEN DISCHARGED FOR MORE THAN 1 YEAR
28 BEFORE THE APPLICATION FOR A LICENSE IS SUBMITTED.

11 PROOF THAT THE APPLICANT IS ASSIGNED TO A DUTY STATION IN THE STATE
12 OR HAS ESTABLISHED LEGAL RESIDENCE IN THE STATE;

13 (4) IF THE APPLICANT IS A MILITARY SPOUSE, PROOF THAT THE
14 APPLICANT'S SPOUSE IS ASSIGNED TO A DUTY STATION IN THE STATE OR HAS
15 ESTABLISHED LEGAL RESIDENCE IN THE STATE;

16 (5) IF A CRIMINAL BACKGROUND CHECK IS REQUIRED BY THE
17 UNIT FOR LICENSURE, PROOF OF APPLICATION FOR A CRIMINAL BACKGROUND
18 CHECK;

19 (6) PROOF THAT THE APPLICANT HAS SUBMITTED THE FULL
20 APPLICATION FOR LICENSURE; AND

21 (7) PAYMENT OF ANY APPLICATION FEE REQUIRED BY THE UNIT.

22 (D) BEFORE ISSUING A TEMPORARY LICENSE UNDER THIS SECTION,
23 THE UNIT SHALL DETERMINE THAT THE REQUIREMENTS FOR LICENSURE IN
24 THE OTHER STATE ARE SUBSTANTIALLY EQUIVALENT TO, OR EXCEED THE
25 REQUIREMENTS FOR, LICENSURE IN THIS STATE.

8 (C) A UNIT MAY NOT ISSUE A LICENSE UNDER THIS SECTION IF

10 OR SAFETY.
