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## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Motor Vehicle Administration – Yellow Dot Program**

3 FOR the purpose of establishing the Yellow Dot Program in the Motor Vehicle  
4 Administration in order to provide a means to alert emergency responders to  
5 health–related information in the event a Program participant is involved in a  
6 vehicle emergency and is unable to communicate; providing that a Program  
7 participant, by affixing a yellow dot decal to a vehicle, consents to a certain  
8 search of the vehicle’s glove compartment or glove box by emergency responders  
9 under certain circumstances; requiring the Administration to design and make  
10 available certain materials necessary to implement and administer the  
11 Program; authorizing the Administration to charge a Program participant a  
12 certain fee; requiring the Administration to publicize the Program and  
13 distribute Program materials in cooperation with certain departments and  
14 certain fire and rescue companies; and generally relating to the Yellow Dot  
15 Program.

2 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
3 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

4 **Article – Transportation**

5 **SUBTITLE 5. YELLOW DOT PROGRAM.**

6 **12-501.**

7 **IN THIS SUBTITLE, “PROGRAM” MEANS THE YELLOW DOT PROGRAM.**

8 **12-502.**

9 **(A) THERE IS A YELLOW DOT PROGRAM IN THE ADMINISTRATION.**

10 **(B) (1) THE PURPOSE OF THE PROGRAM IS TO PROVIDE A MEANS TO**  
11 **ALERT EMERGENCY RESPONDERS TO IMPORTANT HEALTH AND OTHER**  
12 **INFORMATION IN THE EVENT A PROGRAM PARTICIPANT IS INVOLVED IN A**  
13 **MOTOR VEHICLE EMERGENCY AND IS UNABLE TO COMMUNICATE.**

14 **(2) BY AFFIXING A YELLOW DOT PROGRAM WINDOW DECAL ON A**  
15 **MOTOR VEHICLE, A PROGRAM PARTICIPANT CONSENTS TO A SEARCH, BY**  
16 **EMERGENCY RESPONDERS UNDER THE CIRCUMSTANCES DESCRIBED IN**  
17 **PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION, OF THE GLOVE COMPARTMENT OR GLOVE**  
18 **BOX OF THE MOTOR VEHICLE FOR A YELLOW DOT PROGRAM ENVELOPE**  
19 **CONTAINING IMPORTANT HEALTH AND OTHER INFORMATION ABOUT THE**  
20 **PARTICIPANT.**

21 **12-503.**

22 **(A) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL DESIGN AND MAKE AVAILABLE ALL**  
23 **MATERIALS NECESSARY TO IMPLEMENT AND ADMINISTER THE PROGRAM,**  
24 **INCLUDING:**

25 **(1) A YELLOW DOT PROGRAM WINDOW DECAL TO ALERT**  
26 **EMERGENCY RESPONDERS TO A VEHICLE OCCUPANT’S PARTICIPATION IN THE**  
27 **PROGRAM;**

28 **(2) INFORMATION ABOUT THE PROPER PLACEMENT OF THE**  
29 **DECAL;**

30 **(3) HEALTH INFORMATION FORMS CONTAINING A SPACE FOR:**

- 1                   **(I) THE PARTICIPANT’S NAME;**
- 2                   **(II) A PHOTOGRAPH OF THE PARTICIPANT;**
- 3                   **(III) EMERGENCY CONTACT INFORMATION; AND**
- 4                   **(IV) INFORMATION RELATING TO THE PARTICIPANT’S**  
5 **MEDICAL CONDITIONS, RECENT SURGERIES, ALLERGIES, MEDICATIONS BEING**  
6 **USED, AND RELEVANT INFORMATION ABOUT THE PARTICIPANT’S PERSONAL**  
7 **PHYSICIAN; AND**

8                   **(4) READILY IDENTIFIABLE PROGRAM ENVELOPES FOR**  
9 **COMPLETED HEALTH INFORMATION FORMS TO BE STORED IN THE GLOVE**  
10 **COMPARTMENT OR GLOVE BOX OF THE VEHICLE IN WHICH A PARTICIPANT**  
11 **TRAVELS.**

12                   **(B) THE ADMINISTRATION MAY CHARGE A PARTICIPANT A REASONABLE**  
13 **FEE IN AN AMOUNT SUFFICIENT TO OFFSET THE COSTS OF PARTICIPATION IN**  
14 **THE PROGRAM.**

15                   **(C) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL PUBLICIZE THE PROGRAM AND**  
16 **DISTRIBUTE PROGRAM MATERIALS IN COOPERATION WITH:**

- 17                   **(1) THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE POLICE;**
- 18                   **(2) COUNTY AND MUNICIPAL FIRE DEPARTMENTS; AND**
- 19                   **(3) VOLUNTEER FIRE AND RESCUE COMPANIES IN THE STATE.**

20                   SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
21                   October 1, 2013.
