17 18 19	(1) in the year in which the Governor is elected, a certificate of candidacy shall be filed not later than 9 p.m. on the Wednesday following the second Tuesday in April in the year in which the primary election will be held; and
20 21 22	(2) for any other regularly scheduled election], a certificate of candidacy shall be filed not later than 9 p.m. on the Wednesday that is 83 days before the day on which the primary election will be held.
