#### (1) (1) THIS SUBSECTION APPLIES ONLY IN FREDERICK COUNTY.

2 (2) [In Frederick County, where the licensed place of business is 3 located in an incorporated town, 50 percent of the license fee shall be paid to the 4 incorporated town, and the remaining 50 percent, and all license fees for places of 5 business located outside an incorporated town, shall be turned over by the Board of 6 County Commissioners to the County Treasurer.] THE BOARD OF LICENSE 7 COMMISSIONERS SHALL:

8 (I) KEEP 50% OF ALL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LICENSE 9 FEES COLLECTED; AND
