- 15 This subsection only applies to an individual who holds a license and who seeks a different class license to drive a motor vehicle that, under the 16 individual's current license, the individual is not authorized to drive. 17
- 18 The holder of a learner's instructional permit may not take the driver's license examination sooner than 14 days after the permit is issued. 19
- 20 The 14 days' requirement may be waived if a subsequent learner's 21instructional permit is issued or applied for.

1	(4) A learner's instructional permit issued to an individual described
2	in paragraph (1) of this subsection expires:
3	(I) FOR A LEARNER'S INSTRUCTIONAL PERMIT FOR A
4	MOTORCYCLE, 1 YEAR AFTER THE DATE OF ISSUANCE; OR
5	(II) FOR ANY OTHER LEARNER'S INSTRUCTIONAL PERMIT,
6	180 days after THE date of issuance.
7	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
