CHAPTER _____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Environment – Wastewater Treatment Facilities – Financial Assistance Study**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of the Environment, in consultation
4 with local government officials, to conduct a review of State programs that
5 provide financial assistance for certain costs at certain wastewater treatment
6 facilities; requiring the Department to report to the General Assembly on or
7 before a certain date; and generally relating to wastewater treatment facilities.

8 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
9 MARYLAND, That:

10 (a) In consultation with local government officials, the Department of the
11 Environment shall conduct a review of State programs that provide financial

1 assistance for costs relating to the planning, design, construction, and upgrade of
2 wastewater treatment facilities located in the State, including:

3 (1) for the period between fiscal year 2006 and fiscal year 2013, the
4 amount awarded to each wastewater treatment facility with a design capacity of
5 500,000 gallons or more per day;

6 (2) for the period between fiscal year 2006 and fiscal year 2013, the
7 amount awarded to each wastewater treatment facility with a design capacity of less
8 than 500,000 gallons per day; and

9 (3) an analysis of debt service costs among users of wastewater
10 treatment facilities receiving financial assistance from the State, including a
11 comparison of debt service costs among users of facilities with a design capacity of
12 500,000 gallons or more per day and users of facilities with a design capacity of less
13 than 500,000 gallons per day.

14 (b) On or before December 15, 2013, the Department of the Environment
15 shall report, to the General Assembly, in accordance with § 2-1246 of the State
16 Government Article, on the results of the review required under subsection (a) of this
17 section.

18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
19 June 1, 2013.
