3 SEWER LINE, PIPE, OR FIXTURE THAT IS CONNECTED TO THE SANITARY SEWER
4 SYSTEM OF THE COMMISSION, THE COMMISSION SHALL:

- 5 (1) NOTIFY THE COUNTY AND ANY MUNICIPAL CORPORATION IN 6 WHICH THE SEWAGE LEAK IS LOCATED ABOUT:
