11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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Article – Public Safety

14 2-402.

(a) (1) In accordance with the State budget, the Secretary shall appoint
the employees that the Secretary considers necessary for the efficient administration
of the Department.

18 (2) The Secretary shall make each appointment from a list of eligible19 candidates in accordance with the State Personnel and Pensions Article.

- 20 (b) Each **CIVILIAN** appointee to the Department shall:

- (1) be a resident of the State on the date of appointment; and
