A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Procurement – Minority Business Enterprises – Reporting of Architectural**
3 **Services and Engineering Services Contracts**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring certain units of State government to report to certain
5 entities information concerning procurements by the unit for architectural
6 services and engineering services involving minority business enterprises for
7 the preceding fiscal year; altering certain definitions; and generally relating to
8 the reporting of procurements for architectural services and engineering
9 services and minority business enterprises.

20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
21 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

22 **Article – State Finance and Procurement**

23 11–101.

24 (b) (1) “Architectural services” means professional or creative work that:

1 (i) is performed in connection with the design and supervision
2 of construction or landscaping; and

3 (ii) requires architectural education, training, and experience.

4 (2) “Architectural services” includes consultation, research,
5 investigation, evaluation, planning, architectural design and preparation of related
6 documents, and coordination of services that structural, civil, mechanical, and
7 electrical engineers and other consultants provide.

8 (3) “Architectural services” does not include construction inspection
9 services [or], services provided in connection with an energy performance contract
10 **FOR STRUCTURAL, MECHANICAL, PLUMBING, OR ELECTRICAL ENGINEERING.**

11 (i) (1) “Engineering services” means professional or creative work that:

12 (i) is performed in connection with any utility, structure,
13 building, machine, equipment, or process, **INCLUDING STRUCTURAL, MECHANICAL,**
14 **PLUMBING, ELECTRICAL, GEOTECHNICAL, AND ENVIRONMENTAL ENGINEERING;**
15 and

16 (ii) requires engineering education, training, and experience in
17 the application of special knowledge of the mathematical, physical, and engineering
18 sciences.

19 (2) “Engineering services” includes consultation, investigation,
20 evaluation, planning, design, and inspection of construction to interpret and ensure
21 compliance with specifications and design within the scope of inspection services.

22 (3) “Engineering services” does not include services provided in
23 connection with an energy performance contract.

25 (a) (1) Within 90 days after the end of the fiscal year, each unit shall
26 report to the Governor’s Office of Minority Affairs, the certification agency, and,
27 subject to § 2–1246 of the State Government Article, the Joint Committee on Fair
28 Practices and Personnel Oversight.

29 (2) A report under this subsection shall for the preceding fiscal year:

30 (i) state the total number and value of procurement contracts
31 between the unit and certified minority business enterprises, by specific category of
32 minority business enterprise, including whether the minority business enterprise
33 participated as a prime contractor or as a subcontractor;

1 (ii) indicate the percentage that those procurement contracts
2 represent, by specific category of minority business enterprise, of the total number and
3 value of procurement contracts;

4 (iii) state the total number and the names of certified minority
5 business enterprises that participated as prime contractors or as subcontractors on
6 procurement contracts awarded by a unit;

7 (iv) for each minority business included in the report under item
8 (iii) of this paragraph, list all procurement contracts awarded by a unit to the minority
9 business enterprise, including a description of the contract; and

10 (v) contain other such information as required by the
11 Governor's Office of Minority Affairs and the certification agency and approved by the
12 Board.

13 **(3) AS TO PROCUREMENT CONTRACTS FOR ARCHITECTURAL**
14 **SERVICES AND ENGINEERING SERVICES REPORTED UNDER PARAGRAPH (2) OF**
15 **THIS SUBSECTION, THE REPORT SHALL IDENTIFY BY SEPARATE CATEGORY OF**
16 **MINORITY BUSINESS ENTERPRISE PROCUREMENTS FOR:**

17 **(I) ARCHITECTURAL SERVICES; AND**

18 **(II) ENGINEERING SERVICES.**

19 **[(3)] (4)** A report under this subsection shall be in a form prescribed
20 by the Governor's Office of Minority Affairs and the certification agency and approved
21 by the Board.

22 (b) (1) On or before December 31 of each year, the Governor's Office of
23 Minority Affairs shall submit to the Board of Public Works and, subject to § 2-1246 of
24 the State Government Article, to the Legislative Policy Committee a report
25 summarizing the information the Office receives under subsection (a) of this section.

26 (2) This report may be prepared in conjunction with the annual report
27 required under § 9-306 of the State Government Article.

28 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
29 June 1, 2013.
