4 FOR the purpose of requiring an individual to ~~be licensed~~ provide certain evidence of
5 successful completion of a certain landfill management training course that has
6 been approved by the Department of the Environment before an individual may
7 operate a landfill in the State; ~~requiring an applicant to meet certain~~
8 ~~qualifications for a license; requiring~~ authorizing the Department to adopt
9 certain regulations; and generally relating to operating a landfill in the State.

12 Section 9–2001 to be under the new subtitle “Subtitle 20. Landfill Operators”

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article – Environment**

18 **SUBTITLE 20. LANDFILL OPERATORS.**

19 **9–2001.**

 3 THAT HAS BEEN APPROVED BY THE DEPARTMENT BEFORE THE INDIVIDUAL
 4 MAY OPERATE A LANDFILL IN THE STATE.

5 ~~(B) TO QUALIFY FOR A LICENSE, AN APPLICANT SHALL MEET THE~~
 6 ~~REQUIREMENTS ESTABLISHED BY THE DEPARTMENT BY REGULATION.~~

7 ~~(C) (B) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS TO~~
 8 ~~ESTABLISH QUALIFICATIONS FOR THE ISSUANCE AND RENEWAL OF LICENSES~~
 9 IMPLEMENT THE REQUIREMENTS UNDER THIS SECTION.

10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
 11 October 1, 2013.
