## A BILL ENTITLED

2	Video Lottery Operation Licensees - Employee Data Collection

FOR the purpose of requiring a video lottery operation licensee to compile certain data concerning its employees and submit the data to the State Lottery and Gaming Control Commission on or before a certain date; requiring the Commission to submit a certain report to the General Assembly and certain other persons within a certain time; and generally relating to video lottery operation licensees and the State Lottery and Gaming Control Commission.

## 21 Article – State Government

- 23 (a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.
- 24 (k) "Commission" means the State Lottery and Gaming Control Commission.



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- 2 (D) (1) ON OR BEFORE MARCH 31 OF EACH YEAR, A VIDEO LOTTERY 3 OPERATION LICENSEE SHALL:
- 4 (I) COMPILE DATA ON THE AGE, SEX, RACE, AND COUNTY 5 OF RESIDENCE OF ITS EMPLOYEES OF THE PREVIOUS YEAR; AND
- 6 (II) SUBMIT THE DATA TO THE COMMISSION.
- 7 (2) WITHIN 3 MONTHS AFTER RECEIVING THE DATA REQUIRED
  8 UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE COMMISSION SHALL SUBMIT
  9 A REPORT CONTAINING THE DATA TO THE GOVERNOR, THE GOVERNOR'S
  10 OFFICE OF MINORITY AFFAIRS, AND, SUBJECT TO § 2–1246 OF THE STATE
  11 GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE AND THE SPEAKER
- 12 OF THE HOUSE OF DELEGATES.
- 13 (3) THE COMMISSION SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY 14 OUT THIS SUBSECTION.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2013.
