A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Video Lottery Operation Licensees – Employee Data Collection**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring a video lottery operation licensee to compile certain data
4 concerning its employees and submit the data to the State Lottery and Gaming
5 Control Commission on or before a certain date; requiring the Commission to
6 submit a certain report to the General Assembly and certain other persons
7 within a certain time; and generally relating to video lottery operation licensees
8 and the State Lottery and Gaming Control Commission.

19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
20 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

21 **Article – State Government**

22 9–1A–01.

23 (a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.

24 (k) “Commission” means the State Lottery and Gaming Control Commission.

2 (D) (1) ON OR BEFORE MARCH 31 OF EACH YEAR, A VIDEO LOTTERY
3 OPERATION LICENSEE SHALL:

4 (I) COMPILE DATA ON THE AGE, SEX, RACE, AND COUNTY
5 OF RESIDENCE OF ITS EMPLOYEES OF THE PREVIOUS YEAR; AND

6 (II) SUBMIT THE DATA TO THE COMMISSION.

7 (2) WITHIN 3 MONTHS AFTER RECEIVING THE DATA REQUIRED
8 UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE COMMISSION SHALL SUBMIT
9 A REPORT CONTAINING THE DATA TO THE GOVERNOR, THE GOVERNOR'S
10 OFFICE OF MINORITY AFFAIRS, AND, SUBJECT TO § 2-1246 OF THE STATE
11 GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE AND THE SPEAKER
12 OF THE HOUSE OF DELEGATES.

13 (3) THE COMMISSION SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY
14 OUT THIS SUBSECTION.

15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
16 October 1, 2013.
