A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

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- 3 FOR the purpose of establishing the Task Force to Study the Need for Recess in Maryland Public Schools; providing for the composition, chair, and staffing of 4 5 the Task Force; prohibiting a member of the Task Force from receiving certain 6 compensation, but authorizing the reimbursement of certain expenses; 7 requiring the Task Force to study and make recommendations regarding certain 8 matters; requiring the Task Force to report its findings and recommendations to 9 the Governor and the General Assembly on or before a certain date; providing for the termination of this Act; and generally relating to the Task Force to 10 Study the Need for Recess in Maryland Public Schools. 11
- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 13 MARYLAND, That:
- 14 (a) There is a Task Force to Study the Need for Recess in Maryland Public 15 Schools.
- 16 (b) The Task Force consists of the following members:
- 17 (1) two members of the Senate of Maryland, appointed by the 18 President of the Senate;
- 19 (2) two members of the House of Delegates, appointed by the Speaker 20 of the House;
- 21 (3) the State Superintendent of Schools, or the Superintendent's 22 designee;
- 23 (4) one member appointed by the Maryland Association of Boards of 24 Education;
