A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loan of 2003 – Wicomico County –**
3 **Salisbury City Park**

4 FOR the purpose of amending the Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loan of 2003
5 to extend the deadline to a certain date to expend or encumber funds for a
6 certain grant for the Salisbury City Park; and generally relating to amending
7 the Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loan of 2003.

8 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
9 Chapter 204 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2003, as amended by
10 Chapter 396 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2011
11 Section 12(3)(AQ)

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Chapter 204 of the Acts of 2003, as amended by Chapter 396 of the Acts of**
15 **2011**

16 SECTION 12. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That:

18 (AQ) Salisbury City Park. Provide a grant equal to the lesser of (i)
19 \$150,000 or (ii) the amount of the matching fund provided, to
20 the Mayor and City Council of Salisbury for the repair and
21 reconstruction of the historic bandstand pavilion, pedestrian
22 bridges, the Beaverdam Bridge, the Picnic Island Bridge, and
23 the Memorial Drive bridges located in the City Park in
24 Salisbury, subject to the requirement that the grantee grant
25 and convey an historic easement to the Maryland Historical

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1 Trust. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 12(5) of this
 2 Act, the matching fund may include in kind contributions.
 3 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the proceeds of
 4 the loan must be expended or encumbered by the Board of
 5 Public Works for the purposes provided in this act no later
 6 than December 1, ~~[2012]~~ **2015** (Wicomico County) 150,000

7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
 8 June 1, 2013.
