18 (A) A RETAIL LICENSEE LICENSED UNDER THIS ARTICLE MAY NOT SELL 19 ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES BY MEANS OF A SELF–SCANNING CASH REGISTER OR 20 OTHER AUTOMATED SYSTEM THAT IS:
