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1 (c) (1) The term of a member who is appointed under subsection (b) of this 2 section is 3 years.

3 (2) The terms of the members who are appointed under subsection (b) 4 of this section are staggered as required by the terms provided for members of the 5 Commission on October 1, 2003.

6 (3) At the end of a term, a member who is appointed under subsection 7 (b) of this section continues to serve until a successor is appointed and qualifies.

8 (4) A member who is appointed after a term has begun serves only for 9 the remainder of the term and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.

10 (d) Except for the three members appointed by the Secretary under 11 subsection (b) of this section, a member of the Commission may serve personally at a 12 Commission meeting or may designate a representative from the member's unit, 13 agency, or association who may act at any meeting to the same effect as if the member 14 were personally present.

15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect16 October 1, 2013.
