1 The following vehicles are exempt from the registration fees specified in (a)  $\mathbf{2}$ this subtitle: 3 A vehicle owned and personally used by an individual who is [at (9)least 65 years old and is] the surviving spouse of a deceased disabled veteran, as 4 defined under § 7–208 of the Tax – Property Article; [and]  $\mathbf{5}$ 6 (10) A Type I or Type II school vehicle owned and operated by a 7religious organization; AND 8 (11) A MOTOR VEHICLE THAT IS OWNED AND PERSONALLY USED 9 BY AN INDIVIDUAL WHO: 10 **(I)** IS THE SURVIVING SPOUSE OF A VETERAN WHO DIED IN 11 COMBAT OR FROM A COMBAT-RELATED INJURY; 12**(II)** HAS NOT REMARRIED; AND 13(III) SUBMITS A COPY OF DD FORM 1300, REPORT OF 14CASUALTY, AS PROVIDED BY THE NATIONAL PERSONNEL RECORDS CENTER, WITH THE APPLICATION FOR REGISTRATION. 1516SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 17October 1, 2013.
