A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Anne Arundel County – Superintendent of Schools – Compensation**

3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting the Anne Arundel County Board of Education from
4 compensating the county superintendent of schools for nonsalary benefits
5 earned in a certain manner; and generally relating to the compensation for the
6 Anne Arundel County superintendent of schools.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article – Education**

15 4–202.

16 (a) Each county superintendent is entitled to the compensation set by the
17 county board.

18 (b) (1) The salary of a county superintendent may not be decreased during
19 his term of office.

20 (2) Each county superintendent shall devote full time to public school
21 business.

1 **(C) IN ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY, THE COUNTY BOARD MAY NOT**
2 **COMPENSATE THE COUNTY SUPERINTENDENT FOR NONSALARY BENEFITS:**

3 **(1) EARNED WHILE EMPLOYED BY ANY OTHER BOARD OF**
4 **EDUCATION OR PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM; OR**

5 **(2) EARNED WHILE EMPLOYED BY THE COUNTY BOARD AT A RATE**
6 **COMPUTED AND PAID IN A MANNER GREATER THAN THAT COMPUTED AND PAID**
7 **TO A CLASSROOM TEACHER IN THE ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOL**
8 **SYSTEM.**

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
10 October 1, 2013.
