A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

Public Safety – Handgun Permit Background Check – Armored Car Company Employees

- FOR the purpose of authorizing the Secretary of State Police to accept certain
 background checks from certain armored car companies in place of a certain
 criminal history records check performed by the Department of Public Safety
 and Correctional Services under certain circumstances; and generally relating
 to handgun permit background checks.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 16 Article Public Safety
- 17 5–305.

(a) In this section, "Central Repository" means the Criminal Justice
 Information System Central Repository of the Department of Public Safety and
 Correctional Services.

(b) [The] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (G) OF THIS SECTION,
 THE Secretary shall apply to the Central Repository for a State and national criminal
 history records check for each applicant for a permit.

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1 (c) As part of the application for a criminal history records check, the 2 Secretary shall submit to the Central Repository:

3 (1) two complete sets of the applicant's legible fingerprints taken on 4 forms approved by the Director of the Central Repository and the Director of the 5 Federal Bureau of Investigation;

6 (2) the fee authorized under § 10–221(b)(7) of the Criminal Procedure 7 Article for access to Maryland criminal history records; and

8 (3) the mandatory processing fee required by the Federal Bureau of 9 Investigation for a national criminal history records check.

10 (d) In accordance with §§ 10–201 through 10–234 of the Criminal Procedure 11 Article, the Central Repository shall forward to the applicant and the Secretary a 12 printed statement of the applicant's criminal history record information.

- 13 (e) Information obtained from the Central Repository under this section:

- (1) is confidential and may not be disseminated; and

15 (2) shall be used only for the licensing purpose authorized by this 16 section.

17 (f) The subject of a criminal history records check under this section may 18 contest the contents of the printed statement issued by the Central Repository as 19 provided in § 10–223 of the Criminal Procedure Article.

20(G)FOR AN EMPLOYEE OF AN ARMORED CAR COMPANY WHO IS AN21APPLICANT FOR A PERMIT, THE SECRETARY MAY ACCEPT A BACKGROUND22CHECK PERFORMED BY THE ARMORED CAR COMPANY IN PLACE OF THE23CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORDS CHECK REQUIRED BY THIS SECTION IF:

24(1) THE BACKGROUND CHECK MEETS THE MINIMUM25REQUIREMENTS ESTABLISHED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE POLICE; AND

26(2) THE SECRETARY PERFORMS A CURSORY CHECK TO VERIFY27THE FACTS LISTED IN THE BACKGROUND CHECK.
