## CHAPTER \_\_\_\_\_

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Vehicle Laws – Maximum Speed Limits on Highways**

3 FOR the purpose of increasing the maximum speed limit that may be established on  
4 certain highways in the State; and generally relating to maximum speed limits  
5 on highways.

6 BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments,  
7 Article – Transportation

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Article – Transportation**

2 (b) Except as otherwise provided in this section, the maximum speed limits  
3 are:

4 (1) 15 miles an hour in alleys in Baltimore County;

5 (2) 30 miles an hour on:

6 (i) All highways in a business district; and

7 (ii) Undivided highways in a residential district;

8 (3) 35 miles an hour on divided highways in a residential district;

9 (4) 50 miles an hour on undivided highways in other locations; and

10 (5) 55 miles an hour on divided highways in other locations.

11 (d) Except as provided in subsection (e) of this section, a maximum speed  
12 limit specified in subsection (b) of this section or in effect under subsection (c) of this  
13 section may be altered as provided in this subtitle.

14 (e) (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of this subtitle, a maximum  
15 speed limit of more than 55 miles an hour may not be established or continued on any  
16 highway in this State that:

17 (i) Is not an interstate highway or an expressway; or

18 (ii) Would subject the State to federal funding sanctions under  
19 23 United States Code § 154.

20 (2) Subject to the provisions of paragraph (1) of this subsection, a  
21 maximum speed limit of more than [65] ~~75~~ 70 miles an hour may not be established  
22 on any highway in the State.

23 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
24 October 1, 2013.
