A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Business Regulation – Retail Service Stations – Video Cameras Required**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring each retail service station dealer to maintain at least
4 one operational video camera on the exterior of the premises of the service
5 station for certain purposes; requiring each retail service station dealer to
6 preserve recordings made by the video camera for at least a certain period of
7 time; establishing a penalty for a violation of this Act; providing for a delayed
8 effective date; and generally relating to video cameras at retail service stations.

20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
21 MARYLAND, That Section(s) 10–324 of Article – Business Regulation of the
22 Annotated Code of Maryland be renumbered to be Section(s) 10–325.

2 **(A) EACH RETAIL SERVICE STATION DEALER SHALL:**

3 **(1) MAINTAIN AT LEAST ONE OPERATIONAL VIDEO CAMERA ON**
4 **THE EXTERIOR PREMISES OF THE SERVICE STATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF**
5 **RECORDING ILLEGAL ACTIVITY; AND**

6 **(2) PRESERVE THE RECORDINGS MADE BY THE VIDEO CAMERA**
7 **FOR AT LEAST 45 CALENDAR DAYS.**

8 **(B) A RETAIL SERVICE STATION DEALER WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION**
9 **IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT**
10 **EXCEEDING \$500.**

11 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
12 October 1, 2014.
