11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article – Natural Resources**

14 8–710.2.

15 (c) A temporary certificate of boat number expires when the first of either of
16 the following occurs:

17 (1) A certificate of boat number for the vessel is issued by the
18 Department; or
