10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
11 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

12 **Article – State Government**

13 **13-411.**

14 **IN RECOGNITION OF THE EMANCIPATION OF THE SLAVES IN THE STATE,**
15 **THE GOVERNOR ANNUALLY SHALL PROCLAIM NOVEMBER 1 AS MARYLAND**
16 **EMANCIPATION DAY.**
