## Dentists, Physicians, and Podiatrists – Dispensing Prescription Drugs – Inspection by Division of Drug Control

# FOR the purpose of altering the requirement that the Division of Drug Control enter and inspect the office of a dentist, physician, or podiatrist who holds a certain permit to dispense prescription drugs to at least annually during the duration of the permit; and generally relating to inspection of the office of a dentist, physician, or podiatrist who holds a permit to dispense prescription drugs.

1 (ii) At least [one more time] ANNUALLY during the duration of 2 the permit; and

3 (2) A renewed dispensing permit at least [two times] ANNUALLY 4 during the duration of the permit.

5 (b) The Division of Drug Control promptly shall report the results of the 6 inspections required under subsection (a) of this section to the respective board of 7 licensure.

8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 9 October 1, 2013.
