Office of the Attorney General – Establishment of a Consumer Affairs Satellite Office in Prince George's County

- 4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Office of the Attorney General to establish a 5 consumer affairs satellite office in Prince George's County; providing for the 6 purpose of establishing the consumer affairs satellite office; requiring the 7 consumer affairs satellite office to provide consumers with certain resources; 8 requiring the Office of the Attorney General to give priority to a certain site in 9 determining where to locate the consumer affairs satellite office; requiring the Office of the Attorney General, on or before a certain date, to report to the 10 Governor and the General Assembly on the operations of the consumer affairs 11 12 satellite office; and generally relating to the establishment by the Office of the Attorney General of a consumer affairs satellite office in Prince George's 13 14 County.
- 15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 16 MARYLAND, That:
- 17 (a) On or before October 1, 2013, the Office of the Attorney General shall 18 establish a consumer affairs satellite office in Prince George's County.
- 19 (b) The purpose of establishing the consumer affairs satellite office is to 20 broaden the reach of the Office of the Attorney General in order to better serve the 21 needs of residents of the Washington metropolitan area for consumer protection 22 services.
- 23 (c) The consumer affairs satellite office shall provide consumers with a variety of resources, including allowing a consumer to:
- 25 (1) file a complaint with a representative of the Office of the Attorney 26 General; and

- 3 (d) In determining where to locate the consumer affairs satellite office in 4 Prince George's County, the Office of the Attorney General shall give priority to a site 5 that is centrally located in the Washington metropolitan area.
 - (e) On or before December 31, 2013, the Office of the Attorney General shall report to the Governor and, in accordance with § 2–1246 of the State Government Article, the General Assembly, on the operations of the consumer affairs satellite office, including the number of consumers the office has served.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2013.
