1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Frederick County – Gaming Permits**

3 FOR the purpose of repealing in Frederick County a certain limitation on the number
4 of certain raffles that may be held on a single day; authorizing the Board of
5 County Commissioners of Frederick County to determine the number of permits
6 to conduct a raffle that certain organizations in Frederick County may receive
7 in a calendar year; and generally relating to raffles in Frederick County.

1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
2 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

3 **Article – Criminal Law**

4 13–1304.

5 (a) Before an organization listed in subsection (b) of this section may conduct
6 a gaming event, the organization shall obtain a permit from the county agency that
7 the county commissioners designate.

8 (b) An organization may conduct a gaming event for its own benefit if the
9 organization is:

10 (1) a bona fide:

11 (i) religious organization;

12 (ii) fraternal organization;

13 (iii) civic organization;

14 (iv) war veterans' organization;

15 (v) hospital;

16 (vi) amateur athletic organization;

17 (vii) patriotic organization;

18 (viii) educational organization; or

19 (ix) charitable organization;

20 (2) a Frederick County volunteer:

21 (i) fire company;

22 (ii) rescue company; or

23 (iii) ambulance company; or

24 (3) an auxiliary for a Frederick County volunteer:

25 (i) fire company;

1 (ii) rescue company; or

2 (iii) ambulance company.

3 (f) (2) During each calendar year, the holder of a gaming event, including
4 a raffle for which the prize drawings are held on a single day, may not hold or receive
5 the proceeds from[:

6 (i)] more than one gaming event in which the major prize has a
7 value of more than \$5,000[; and

8 (ii) more than five raffles for which the prize drawings are held
9 on a single day and in which the major prize has a value of \$5,000 or less].

10 (4) THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MAY REGULATE THE NUMBER
11 OF PERMITS TO CONDUCT A RAFFLE THAT AN ORGANIZATION MAY RECEIVE IN 1
12 CALENDAR YEAR.

13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
14 October 1, 2013.
