A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Frederick County – Gaming Permits**

3 FOR the purpose of repealing in Frederick County a certain limitation on the number
4 of certain raffles that may be held on a single day; authorizing the Board of
5 County Commissioners of Frederick County to determine the number of permits
6 to conduct a raffle that certain organizations in Frederick County may receive
7 in a calendar year; and generally relating to raffles in Frederick County.

23 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
24 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

25 **Article – Criminal Law**

2 (a) Before an organization listed in subsection (b) of this section may conduct
3 a gaming event, the organization shall obtain a permit from the county agency that
4 the county commissioners designate.

5 (b) An organization may conduct a gaming event for its own benefit if the
6 organization is:

7 (1) a bona fide:

8 (i) religious organization;

9 (ii) fraternal organization;

10 (iii) civic organization;

11 (iv) war veterans' organization;

12 (v) hospital;

13 (vi) amateur athletic organization;

14 (vii) patriotic organization;

15 (viii) educational organization; or

16 (ix) charitable organization;

17 (2) a Frederick County volunteer:

18 (i) fire company;

19 (ii) rescue company; or

20 (iii) ambulance company; or

21 (3) an auxiliary for a Frederick County volunteer:

22 (i) fire company;

23 (ii) rescue company; or

24 (iii) ambulance company.

1 (f) (2) During each calendar year, the holder of a gaming event, including
2 a raffle for which the prize drawings are held on a single day, may not hold or receive
3 the proceeds from[:

4 (i)] more than one gaming event in which the major prize has a
5 value of more than \$5,000[; and

6 (ii) more than five raffles for which the prize drawings are held
7 on a single day and in which the major prize has a value of \$5,000 or less].

8 **(4) THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MAY REGULATE THE NUMBER**
9 **OF PERMITS TO CONDUCT A RAFFLE THAT AN ORGANIZATION MAY RECEIVE IN 1**
10 **CALENDAR YEAR.**

11 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
12 October 1, 2013.
