3 FOR the purpose of altering the distribution of alcoholic beverages license fees in
4 Frederick County; requiring that the ~~Board of License Commissioners keep a~~
5 ~~certain percentage of license fees that are collected and that a certain~~
6 ~~percentage of license fees be distributed to the County Treasurer~~ County
7 Treasurer receive all of the license fees that the Board of License
8 Commissioners collects; requiring that all of the salaries and expenses of the
9 Board of License Commissioners be paid from certain license fees; ~~making~~
10 ~~certain stylistic changes~~; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages license
11 fees in Frederick County.

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 **Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages**

2 (2) [In Frederick County, where the licensed place of business is
3 located in an incorporated town, 50 percent of the license fee shall be paid to the
4 incorporated town, and the remaining 50 percent, and all license fees for places of
5 business located outside an incorporated town, shall be turned over by the Board of
6 County Commissioners to the County Treasurer.] ~~THE BOARD OF LICENSE~~

8 ~~(I) KEEP 50% OF ALL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LICENSE~~

14 article] ~~BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS SHALL BE PAID FROM THE~~
15 ~~LICENSE FEES THAT THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS KEEPS~~ THE
16 COUNTY TREASURER SHALL:

17 (I) RECEIVE ALL OF THE LICENSE FEES THAT THE BOARD
18 OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS COLLECTS; AND

19 (II) FROM THOSE FEES, PAY ALL OF THE SALARIES AND
20 EXPENSES OF THE BOARD.

21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
22 July 1, 2013.
